l. Water Source Protection

Report received from engineering firm – independent study done by city for the 27th of February incident.

Mr. Hewitt has stated previously that all the concerns of the citizens along the pipeline route will have their concerns addressed.

One newspaper reporter has expressed surprise on our lack of progress. Harvey will contact him for possible story.

We should request the report from the forcemain on Eagleson on October 27th.

Mayor asked (previously from RVA representatives) what the citizens of Richmond would pay to get the solution they want?

Bringing city based water system would be a minimum of 3 years from start of process.

Question raised concerning response from the various levels of government we have been in contact with. The answer is that we have not received appropriate/valid responses.
